Distinguished Canadian pianist Robert Silverman has received acclaim for his mastery of technique and his inspired, thoughtful interpretations of the great works of the piano repertoire. The first recipient of the Paul de Hueck and Norman Walford Career Achievement Award for Keyboard Artistry, administered by the Ontario Arts Council, he has performed with major symphony orchestras in North America, Europe, Asia, and Australia and has recorded 25 CD's.
